Care of the Altar

The Chairman (*) for each month will be responsible for the following:

1. Notifying members of her group.
2. Changing paraments according to the designated numerical color on the liturgical church calendar.
3. Wash fair linen as needed.
4. Wipe brass after each service with a clean soft cloth.
 - a. **NEVER** use Brasso on the lacquered pieces – the altar cross, the flower vases or the offering plates.
 - b. Use Brasso once a month on the candelabra, the processional cross and the paschal candle.
5. Refill candles with liquid wax every 3rd Sunday or service (see altar care guidelines in the small room next to the chancel for procedure).
6. Prepare for Holy Communion.
7. Place communion cards in pew racks. (Extras are in the guest register in the narthex.)
8. Wash communion set after use and store in designated cabinet in old kitchen.

All linens, including the fair linen and the communion veil, are stored in the top drawer of the parament cabinet.

****NOTE:** Altar care guidelines are posted in the small room next to the chancel.
